Mainstay Of Any Polishing Room For Most Polishing Jobs

Spiral Stitched - used primarily for first cleaning operation on the gun with No. 140 Polish-O-Ray"! to knock off old blue, dirt and rust and bring the metal to a bright finish. Also used by some operators instead of Soft Felt wheels - being of a more flexible nature, great care must be exercised to not round edges, or funnel and elongate screw and pin holes. Loose Muslin - used following each change of grit to smooth out grit marks and prepare the surface for the next finer grit. Also used to finish off the gun just prior to bluing. Note: - Use enough sections to make each wheel as wide as your polishing motor will handle - a minimum of three sections to each wheel. Never try to use the same wheel for different grit numbers. After a wheel is broken-in and in use, mark it with the grit number to be used on it and direction of rotation to be turned. Will increase wheel life, give better finishes and save hours of work.

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the MUSLIN WHEELS BROWNELLS 8" STITCHED MUSLIN WHEEL 3/4" ARBOR. This guide provides important safety information and instructions to ensure safe and effective use of the product. Please read this guide carefully before using the product.

General Safety Guidelines

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation:

- Select the appropriate arbor size for your polishing motor (1/2", 5/8", 3/4", 7/8", or 1").
- Slide the muslin wheel onto the arbor and secure it tightly according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Ensure that the wheel is properly aligned and does not wobble.

2. Usage:

- Start the polishing motor at a low speed to ensure the muslin wheel is properly centered.
- Gradually increase the speed to the recommended setting for optimal performance.
- Apply light pressure to the surface being polished, allowing the muslin wheel to do the work.
- After each change of grit, use the loose muslin to smooth out grit marks and prepare the surface for the next finer grit.
- Mark each wheel with the grit number and direction of rotation to extend wheel life and improve results.
- After polishing, turn off the motor and allow the wheels to come to a complete stop before touching them.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of used muslin wheels in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not burn the muslin wheels, as they may release harmful fumes.
- Recycle packaging materials where facilities exist.
