# 1911 Armorer's AddOn Pak Safety Instructions

## Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the 1911 Armorer's AddOn Pak. This kit contains essential tools designed for the assembly, disassembly, performance improvement, and general maintenance of 1911style pistols. To ensure safe and effective use, please read this safety instruction guide carefully.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### 1. Preparation:

- Ensure you have a clean workspace and all necessary tools from the kit.
- Verify that your firearm is unloaded and safe to work on.

## **2. Using the MagnaTip Solid Handle:**

- Select the appropriate bit for the screw you are working on.
- Insert the bit into the MagnaTip handle and tighten securely.

## **3. Using the Allen Bit:**

- Fit the Allen bit into the handle and engage with the screw.
- Turn clockwise to tighten or counterclockwise to loosen.

## **4. Using the Slotted Bit:**

- Similar to the Allen bit, ensure a secure fit and turn as needed.

## **5. Using the Torx Bit:**

- Engage the Torx bit with the screw, ensuring a firm grip before turning.

## **6. Using the Bushing Driver Bit:**

- Align the bushing driver bit with the bushing and apply gentle pressure to drive it in.

## **7. Using the Bushing Wrench:**

- Place the wrench over the bushing and turn to tighten or loosen.

## **8. Using the Safety Detent Depressor:**

- Insert the safety detent depressor and apply pressure as necessary.

## **9. Using the Mainspring Housing Pin Pusher:**

- Align the pin pusher with the pin and apply pressure to push it out.

## **10. Using the Nylon/Brass Hammer:**

- Use the hammer to gently tap tools as required, avoiding excessive force.

## **11. Using Punches:**

- Align the punch with the desired area and tap gently with the hammer.

## **Disposal Instructions**

- Dispose of any damaged or unused tools in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of tools in regular household waste.
- Check with local authorities for proper disposal methods for metal and plastic materials.
