Convenient kit of genuine Colt factory parts includes all the small parts needed to finish a small-pin AR-15 lower receiver, and install the trigger group and pistol grip of your choice. Or, use the kit to rebuild the worn internals of an old rifle and restore it to like-new function and reliability. The single-manufacturer source—the company that developed the original AR-15/M16 platform and built them for the U.S. military—means the kit parts are designed to work together and will require minimal fitting. Also includes an Accu-Wedge, a high-density rubber insert that fills the space behind the takedown pin to prevent unwanted movement between the receiver halves. Helps the rifle shoot tight, consistent groups.

Introduction

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation

2. Disassembly of the Lower Receiver

- Remove the existing components from the lower receiver carefully.
- Keep track of all removed parts for proper reinstallation.

3. Installation of the Parts Kit

- Start by installing the bolt catch pin, bolt catch plunger, and bolt catch spring as per the kit instructions.
- Follow with the installation of the buffer retainer and buffer retainer spring.
- Install the selector lever, selector detent, and hammer/trigger pins (.154" O.D.).
- Proceed with the mag catch, mag release button, and associated springs.
- Install the pistol grip lock washer and screw, followed by the front pivot pin and rear takedown pin.
- Insert the takedown pin detents and springs.
- Finally, install the trigger guard and its pivot pin, bolt catch, ejector/selector spring, and the AccuWedge.

4. Final Checks

- Ensure all parts are securely installed and function as intended.
- Perform a function check to confirm that the trigger group operates correctly.
- If any issues are noted, consult a qualified gunsmith before using the firearm.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any packaging materials in accordance with local waste regulations.
- If any parts are damaged beyond use, follow local guidelines for the disposal of firearm components.
- Ensure that all parts are rendered unusable before disposal to prevent unauthorized use.
