Kit includes receiver extension tube, recoil buffer, buffer spring, buttstock spacer, and buttstock screw. COLT - From the original manufacturer of the M16 battle rifle. A1 Rifle, A2 Rifle, and Mil-Spec Carbine kits available. Carbine kit contains the four-position, Mil-Spec receiver extension used on the Colt M4 and Law Enforcement carbines.
