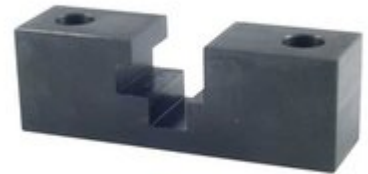

With it, you can prevent expensive receiver damage on MOST popular rifle actions, including military models, plus, models for selected handguns. Intricately machined to fit around the receiver ring and clear the slide ways for solid support on six surface areas. Fits virtually all military and commercial variations.
