Introduction

These precision turned, heat treated screws are designed to provide extra reach when bedding rifle actions in synthetic or wooden stocks. This safety instructions guide aims to ensure the safe use of this product while complying with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR).

 - Allen Head: $\frac{1}{4}''$ 28 x 1.7", $\frac{1}{4}''$ 28 x 2.2", or 836 x 2.2"
- Insert the new screw into the corresponding hole and hand tighten it.
- Using the appropriate tool, tighten the screw to the manufacturer's recommended torque settings. Avoid overtightening.

3. Post Installation Check

- Once all screws are installed, double check each one to ensure they are securely fastened.
- Test the trigger guard for stability before using the rifle.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any unused or damaged screws in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of screws in regular household waste. Check for recycling options or designated disposal sites.
