Both machined-in patterns provide a very secure, non-slip gripping surface, without the "sharpness" of conventional checkering that can sometimes abrade your hand or grab at your clothing during a concealed carry draw. Also available for the Officer's model in blued or stainless steel with 25lpi checkering.
