Safety Instruction Guide for 1911 Oversized Magazine Release

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the 1911 Oversized Magazine Release by Ed Brown. This product is designed to enhance your firearm's magazine changing efficiency while ensuring safety during use. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to understand how to use and maintain the product safely and effectively.

General Safety Guidelines

Instructions for Installation and Usage

Installation

1. Ensure your firearm is unloaded and the magazine is removed.
2. Locate the existing magazine catch on your firearm.
3. Remove the old magazine catch by unscrewing it, ensuring you keep any lock and spring components for reinstallation.
4. Take the new oversized magazine release button and align it with the predrilled hole in the magazine catch.
5. Using a 440 thread screw, secure the magazine release button in place, ensuring it is tightened adequately without overtightening.
6. Reinstall the catch lock and spring if applicable.
7. Test the magazine release to ensure it operates smoothly.

Usage

- To release the magazine, press the oversized magazine release button firmly.
- Ensure your grip on the firearm remains secure while changing magazines.
- Practice changing magazines in a safe environment to become familiar with the new release button.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any old magazine release components in accordance with local regulations.

- If the product has reached the end of its life cycle, dispose of it responsibly by recycling or utilizing a hazardous waste facility if necessary.
