Numerous types of accessories can be added to the many attachment points, including handstops, sling mounts, rails, bipods, monopods, and more. KRG's modular grip panels allow the shooter to tailor the fit of the stock to his/her hand which, combined with the other adjustments, yield a stock set up exactly as it needs to be for that particular shooter. The latest Generation (6) features a new length-of-pull locking mechanism that is a bit more streamlined than previous generations and allows for faster adjustments. Remington 700 long action chassis takes AICS pattern 3.850" length magazines.
