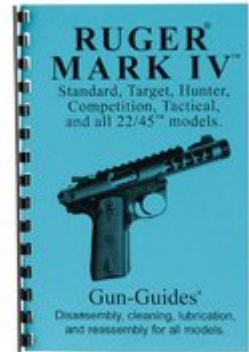

## Introduction
