Safety Instruction Guide for 12GAUGE TRUCHOKE CHOKE TUBES

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the 12GAUGE TRUCHOKE CHOKE TUBES. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe and effective use of this product. Please read all instructions carefully before use.

- Avoid using steel shot loads with choke tubes not designed for such use, as this may cause damage to the tube and shotgun.
- Always ensure that the choke tubes are securely installed before firing.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation:

- Ensure the shotgun is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.
- Remove any existing choke tube from the shotgun.
- Clean the threads of the shotgun barrel to ensure proper installation.
- Insert the TruChoke tube into the barrel and handtighten until snug.
- Use a choke wrench if necessary to ensure a secure fit, but do not overtighten.

2. Usage:

- Load the shotgun according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Aim and fire the shotgun only in a safe direction and in accordance with local laws and regulations.
- After use, inspect the choke tube for any signs of damage or wear.
- Clean the choke tube after each use to prevent buildup of debris.
