Safety Instruction Guide for 1911 Barrel Link Kit

EGW #3

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the 1911 Barrel Link Kit EGW #3. This product is designed to improve the fit and feeding performance of your 1911 auto firearm. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure safe and proper use of the product in compliance with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR).

General Safety Guidelines

- Always handle firearms and firearm components with care and respect.
- Ensure that the product is used only for its intended purpose.

- Select the appropriate barrel link size based on your firearm model:
 - Factory standard #3 (.278")
 - #0 (.015") for Accurail equipped guns with moved rails
 - #1 (.010")
 - #2 (.005")
 - #4 (+.005")
 - #5 (+.010")
- Insert the new barrel link into the barrel.
- Align the barrel link pin hole with the corresponding hole in the barrel.
- Gently tap the pin back into place to secure the new barrel link.

4. Reassembling the Firearm

- Reattach the slide to the frame of the firearm.
- Ensure that all components are securely in place before use.

5. Testing the Installation

- Conduct a function check to ensure proper operation of the firearm.
- Test fire in a safe and controlled environment.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any old or damaged barrel links and packaging in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the product in regular household waste. Instead, follow your local guidelines for hazardous waste disposal if applicable.
