Drilled to fit the factory scope mount holes on the gun's receiver. Accepts Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. Lightweight Tactical mounts have a milled center channel for weight reduction. Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to +/- .002". Machined from ultra-rigid, extruded 6061 T6 aluminum. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite for mounting.

# Safety Instruction Guide for REMINGTON XP/XR 100, 7 3HOLE SHORT ACTION SCOPE BASES

## Introduction

- Apply a drip of blue Loctite to the screws during installation to prevent loosening.

- Avoid using the scope bases in extreme weather conditions or environments that may compromise integrity.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### 1. Preparation

- Gather all necessary tools, including a Torx® wrench.
- Ensure you have a clean and welllit workspace.

### 2. Installation Steps

- Ensure the firearm is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.
- Locate the factory scope mount holes on your firearm's receiver.
- Align the EGW Remington XP/XR 100 scope bases with the mount holes.
- Insert the socket head Torx® screws into the predrilled holes of the scope bases.
- Use the Torx® wrench to tighten the screws to a torque of 20 inch lbs. Avoid overtightening.
- Apply a small amount of blue Loctite to each screw for added security.

### 3. Scope Mounting

- Choose appropriate Picatinny or Weaver scope rings for your scope.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for mounting the scope onto the bases.
- Adjust the eye relief and ensure that the scope is level.

### 4. Final Checks

- Doublecheck all screws and connections to ensure they are secure.
- Conduct a function check by cycling the action of the firearm without ammunition.

## **Disposal Instructions**

- Dispose of packaging materials in accordance with local regulations.
- If the product is no longer in use, consider recycling or disposing of it in an environmentally friendly manner. Check with local waste management for proper disposal methods.
