Drilled to fit the factory scope mount holes on the gun's receiver. Accepts Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. Lightweight Tactical mounts have a milled center channel for weight reduction. Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to $\pm .002$ ". Machined from ultra-rigid, extruded 6061 T6 aluminum. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite for mounting.

Safety Instruction Guide for RUGER® NO.1® SCOPE BASES EGW RUGER NO. 1 VARMINT 0 MOA

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the EGW Ruger No.1 Varmint Scope Bases. This guide provides essential safety information and instructions for the proper installation and use of your scope bases. Please read this guide carefully to ensure safe and effective use.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation

- Ensure the firearm is unloaded and in a safe position.
- Gather all necessary tools: Torx® wrench and blue loctite.

2. Installation

- Align the scope bases with the factory scope mount holes on the firearm's receiver.
- Insert the socket head Torx® screws into the mounting holes.
- Tighten the screws gradually, ensuring even pressure across the bases.
- Use a torque wrench to apply 20 inch lbs of torque to each screw.
- Apply a small amount of blue loctite to each screw to secure them in place.

3. Usage

- Once installed, mount your choice of Picatinny or Weaver scope rings onto the scope bases.
- Adjust the scope for proper eye relief and secure it according to the scope ring manufacturer's instructions.
- Conduct a function check to ensure all components are securely attached before using the firearm.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any packaging materials in accordance with local waste management regulations.
- If the scope bases are damaged beyond repair, contact your local waste disposal service for safe disposal.
