Drilled to fit the factory scope mount holes on the gun's receiver. Accepts Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. Lightweight Tactical mounts have a milled center channel for weight reduction. Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to  $\pm .002$ ". Machined from ultra-rigid, extruded 6061 T6 aluminum. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite for mounting.

# Safety Instruction Guide for EGW Savage Edge/Axis Scope Bases

## Introduction

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### 1. Preparation

- Gather all necessary tools: a socket head Torx wrench and blue Loctite.
- Ensure the firearm is unloaded and in a safe area for installation.

### 2. Installation Steps

- Locate the factory scope mount holes on the receiver of your Savage Edge/Axis firearm.
- Align the EGW Savage Edge/Axis Scope Bases with the mount holes.
- Insert the socket head Torx screws into the base and tighten them gently.
- Apply a drip of blue Loctite to each screw to prevent loosening.
- Use the Torx wrench to tighten each screw to a torque of 20 inch lbs. Do not overtighten.
- Check that the scope bases are securely attached and that there is no movement.

### 3. Usage

- After installation, mount your scope onto the Picatinny rail.
- Adjust the scope to achieve the desired eye relief and ensure a comfortable shooting position.
- Regularly check the tightness of the screws and the condition of the scope bases during use.

## **Disposal Instructions**

- Dispose of any packaging materials responsibly and in accordance with local regulations.
- If the scope bases are damaged beyond repair, dispose of them in a manner that complies with local waste disposal regulations.
- Do not dispose of the product in household waste. Check for recycling options in your area.
