EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite for mounting.

- Apply a small drop of blue Loctite to each screw to secure them in place.

3. PostInstallation Check:

- After installation, check that the scope base is securely attached.
- Ensure there is no movement when applying pressure to the scope base.
- Confirm that the scope can be mounted securely and is level.

4. Usage:

- Once installed, you may attach your Picatinny or Weaver scope rings.

- Adjust your scope to the desired eye relief for optimal viewing.
- Regularly check the tightness of the screws before each use.
