The Winchester Vented is a copy of the original pad on early 1920's Winchesters the includes the Winchester logo and the legend "MADE IN U.S.A." above the logo and "TRADE MARK PAT. JUNE 6, 1922" correctly placed below it. Winchester Solid is a solid red pad modeled after that of many original pre-'64 Winchesters including the Model 70, Model 12, Model 21, plus all lever action and pump models. Raised lettering Winchester logo. Early Noshoc pad provides an opportunity to put the correct era pad on many high-grade American guns. Used by Parker, Fox, L.C. Smith, Remington, Winchester, and Lefever. Raised lettering reads "NOSHOC" with the legend "PATENTED JUNE 6, 1922" above the logo and "MADE IN U.S.A" below it. The Universal pad is available in red and works well on a variety of custom stocks. Screw holes are $3\frac{1}{4}$ " apart; midway between these holes is an internal cavity $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide and $2\frac{1}{8}$ " long.
