

# ASSAULT BACK PANEL CORE - SPIRITUS SYSTEMS ASSAULT BACK PANEL CORE - MULTICAM BLACK

The top of the Panel features a custom double pull, separating zipper. This zipper serves three purposes. It allows the Flaps to be completely removed from the Core and swapped out. It allows communication antennas and other items such as cabling, hydration tubes, and breaching tools to be routed into and out of the top of the panel. It provides quick access to the inside of the panel without lifting the entire Flap. The Assault Panel Core also has three direction snaps to hold Flaps securely on and to keep tools held inside the panel. The Assault Panel Core features 4 external attachment zippers. These zippers allow the panel to be worn in three configurations. Configuration 1 uses the top zippers to attach the panel to the plate bag. This compresses the panel and allows the panel to be worn in a "light" configuration. This configuration of the panel is great for assaulters who want a streamlined and tight configuration and only need to carry things like a small hydration bladder, slap charges, flash bangs and GP kit on their backs. Configuration 2 uses the bottom zippers to attach the panel to the plate bag. This configuration gives the user much more capacity and configures the panel into more of a backpack. This provides the same features as Configuration 1, but with the added volume for bulky items such as radios, cold weather gear, poll less litters, etc. Configuration 3 also uses the bottom zippers to attach to the rear plate bag, but introduces the bottom expansion as well. This expansion offers the ability to carry longer tools and store even more bulky items in the expanded space. The Assault Panel Core comes standard with a permanently affixed large GP pocket on the lower half. This pocket is velcro lined for attachment of accessory items. It features a total of two tie down locations inside the pouch for securing sensitive equipment. The front of the pouch features a zippered stash pocket for organizing smaller, commonly needed items. This pocket also has a 4" x 5" Velcro Field for attaching identification patches. Behind the GP pocket is a hidden stash compartment. This is used for storing the lower half of slap charges or breach pens when they are passed through the flaps above. It can also be used to stash E&E equipment or smaller personal items. Each side of the panel features six tie down loops for securing longer items external to the panel. These loops are great for attaching Tri-Fold or Bi-Fold charges or other tall items. The bottom expansion has a G-Hook internal to the panel that allows you to secure it in place if a heavier load needs to be carried inside, but you do not want the expansion to deploy inadvertently. Fitment Guide Medium Overt Plate Bags - Fits Large Overt Plate Bags - Fits, could use an XL Adapter if you have very thick plates, and are overloading the panel. Extra Large Overt Plate Bags - Needs an XL Adapter to be compatible with the XL Plate Bags. Some images shown with optional accessories, sold separately.

# Safety Instruction Guide for ASSAULT BACK PANEL CORE SPIRITUS SYSTEMS

## Introduction

- **Configuration 2:**
  - Use the bottom zippers to attach the panel to the plate bag for increased capacity.
  - This configuration allows for larger items like radios and cold weather gear.
- **Configuration 3:**
  - Also use the bottom zippers, but utilize the bottom expansion for carrying longer tools and more bulky items.

### 2. Attaching Flaps:

- Ensure the flaps are securely attached using the three direction snaps to prevent them from coming loose during use.

### 3. Using the GP Pocket:

- The large GP pocket on the lower half is velcro lined for accessories. Ensure items are secured with

the tiedown locations provided.

- Use the zippered stash pocket for smaller items that need to be organized.

#### **4. Storing Items:**

- Utilize the hidden stash compartment behind the GP pocket for storing items like breach pens or E&E equipment.
- Use the six tiedown loops on each side of the panel for securing longer items externally.

#### **5. Expansion Use:**

- If carrying heavier loads, use the GHook internal to the panel to secure the bottom expansion in place.

## **Disposal Instructions**

- When disposing of the panel, ensure that it is done in an environmentally responsible manner.
- Follow local regulations for the disposal of textile products.
- If the panel is damaged beyond repair, consider recycling the materials where possible.
