*** This product attaches to the ASSAULT BACK PANEL CORE. It is NOT standalone and requires a Core to function properly.*** GP Flap The GP Flap is a single pocket zip on attachment to our Assault Back Panel Core. It consists of one pocket that measures 10" x 6" x 2.5" The pocket was built to store extra items that may be needed on an operation such as medical equipment or roll up flex linear charges. The pocket features a half zippered closure to prevent items from inadvertently dumping out unzipping the pouch. Inside the pocket there is Velcro loop lined on both sides for the addition of hook Velcro accessories. There are also two tie down locations on the interior for securing sensitive items. The GP Flap has two built-in channels behind the pocket that allows for the storage of linear items, such as Slap Charges and Breach Pens. The front of the pocket offers a smaller zippered stash pocket for organizing smaller items and features a loop Velcro field that measures 2" x 9" for attaching placards or velcro patches. The GP flap is attached to the Assault Back Panel Core by a separating dual zipper, 3 directional snaps and a hook/loop Velcro field. Some images show with optional accessories, sold separately.

Safety Instruction Guide for BACK PANEL GP FLAP SPIRITUS SYSTEMS

Introduction

This product is designed to enhance your Assault Back Panel Core by providing additional storage for essential items during operations. - Use the half zippered closure to minimize the risk of items falling out during movement.
- Be cautious when accessing the pocket to avoid sharp objects or equipment that may be stored inside.
- When using the interior tiedown locations, ensure that sensitive items are securely fastened to prevent movement during use.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation:

- Align the GP Flap with the Assault Back Panel Core.
- Securely attach the GP Flap using the separating dual zipper, ensuring it is fully zipped.
- Fasten the 3 directional snaps to provide additional stability.
- Check that the hook/loop Velcro field is firmly engaged.

2. Usage:

- Utilize the main pocket to store items such as medical equipment or rollup flex linear charges.
- Use the smaller zippered stash pocket for organizing smaller items.
- Attach placards or Velcro patches to the loop Velcro field that measures 2" x 9".
- Ensure that linear items are stored in the builtin channels behind the pocket.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the BACK PANEL GP FLAP in accordance with local regulations for textile and plastic waste.
- If the product is damaged beyond repair, ensure that it is disposed of in a way that prevents it from being reused inappropriately.
