

HAND STOP FOR PICATINNY - ARISAKA DEFENSE HAND STOP PICATINNY

Description The Patent Pending Arisaka Hand Stop is a continuation of Arisaka's low profile, minimal control accessories. The primary goal of this accessory is to aid the user in pulling their rifle into their shoulder, enhancing control and recoil mitigation. The Hand Stop can also be used as a barricade stop, or reversed and placed at the front of the handguard to prevent the support hand from slipping off the end. The size and profile were designed to fit a wide variety of hands without being too large to get in the way. The Arisaka Hand Stop Picatinny uses a unique recoil lug that extends from inside the part, providing a secure, rattle free lockup. The recoil lug and patched mating screw are captured and cannot fall out when the Hand Stop is removed from the Picatinny rail. A rotation direction indication is CNC engraved onto the part to aid in tightening or loosening the recoil lug. A 7/64" Allen wrench is required for installation, with a maximum torque specification of 15 inch lbs. Specs Height: 1.3" Width: 1.19" at Picatinny clamp, 0.625" at main interface where your hand or fingers contact. Length: 1.1" Weight: 0.84 oz The Hand Stop is CNC machined from 6061-T651 aluminum and MIL-A-8625 Type III hard coat anodized. Requires a 7/64" Allen wrench for installation (not included). Maximum torque: 15 inch lbs. Hardware: One 6-32x1/2" hex cap head screw, one HS-P recoil lug. Made in the USA.

Introduction

Instructions for Installation and Usage

- Gather the necessary tools: a 7/64" Allen wrench (not included).
- Locate the Picatinny rail on your firearm.
- Position the Hand Stop at your desired location on the rail.
- Insert the provided 632x1/2" hex cap head screw through the recoil lug into the Picatinny rail.
- Tighten the screw using the Allen wrench. Ensure the rotation direction indicated on the part is followed for proper tightening.
- Check that the Hand Stop is securely attached and does not rattle.

2. Usage:

- Grip the Hand Stop firmly with your support hand while shouldering the rifle.
- Use the Hand Stop to pull the rifle into your shoulder for enhanced control.
- If needed, reverse the Hand Stop and place it at the front of the handguard to prevent your support hand from slipping off.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the Hand Stop in accordance with local regulations regarding aluminum and electronic waste.
- Do not dispose of the product in regular household waste.
