Snap caps are great for dry fire practice because they let you concentrate on keeping the firearm steady during the trigger pull, which helps eliminate flinch when using live ammo. Centerfire Pistol and Rifle caps have a solid aluminum body and a spring-loaded brass "primer" that absorbs firing pin impact to prevent damage to the tip of the firing pin.

Introduction

Thank you for choosing Carlson's Snap Caps for your dry fire practice. This guide provides essential safety information to ensure the safe and effective use of your snap caps. Please read this guide carefully before using the product.

- Take a snap cap from the package.
- Insert the snap cap into the chamber of the firearm as you would with a live round.
- Close the action of the firearm securely.

3. Dry Fire Practice:

- Practice your trigger pull technique without flinching.
- Focus on maintaining a steady aim while pulling the trigger.
- After practice, remove the snap caps from the chamber.

4. PostUse:

- Always inspect snap caps for wear or damage after use.
- Store snap caps in a safe, dry location when not in use.

- Dispose of damaged or worn snap caps according to local regulations.
- Do not dispose of snap caps in regular household waste if they are damaged; check for local recycling or hazardous waste disposal options.
