Introduction

 - Adjust the powder thru expanding die for the desired expansion.
 - Insert a clean case and raise the ram to expand the case mouth.
 - Use the Powder Dipper to measure and dispense the appropriate amount of powder into the expanded case.
3. **Bullet Seating:**
 - Place a bullet on the charged case.
 - Adjust the bullet seating die to ensure proper seating depth.
 - Raise the ram to seat the bullet securely in the case.

4. Final Inspection:

- Inspect each round for proper seating and overall quality before storage or use.

- Dispose of any damaged or worn reloading components according to local regulations.
