Durable tactical slings provide a wide variety of comfortable carry options while ensuring rapid, smooth transitions to a shooting stance. These slings are manufactured from durable, mil-spec materials, featuring close-weave nylon webbing, heavy-duty 800-lb. tensile strength elastic, double stitching and shockproof polymer hardware that won't rattle or rust. Quick-release buckles can be disengaged with one hand, and tri-glide slip locks let the operator adjust overall length quickly for rapid shifts from strong side to support side and back. A-Tac - Single-point sling fits any weapon that accepts an HK-type snap hook. Provides maximum range of weapon movement for fast transition from many carry positions, including over either shoulder, across the back, under the opposing arm, and around the neck. Three-point polymer buckle allows selective release of the left side of the strap, the right side, or both simultaneously to free the weapon from the sling. Duty - Basic two-point sling of straight 1¼" wide nylon webbing attaches easily to USGI sling swivel. Loops through rear swivel, secures at front with two steel screw closures.

Safety Instruction Guide for TACTICAL SLINGS OUTDOOR CONNECTION DUTY TWOPOINT SLING

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the TACTICAL SLINGS OUTDOOR CONNECTION DUTY TWOPOINT SLING. This guide provides important safety information to ensure the safe use, installation, and disposal of your sling. Please read this guide carefully before using the product.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

Installation

1. ATac SinglePoint Sling:

- Attach the HKtype snap hook to the designated attachment point on your weapon.
- Ensure the snap hook is securely fastened.

2. Duty TwoPoint Sling:

- Loop the sling through the rear swivel of your weapon.
- Secure the front of the sling using the two steel screw closures.
- Adjust the length of the sling using the triglide slip locks for a comfortable fit.

Usage

- To transition the sling from strong side to support side:
 - Release the quickrelease buckle with one hand.
 - Adjust the sling length as needed using the triglide slip locks.
 - Resecure the buckle once the desired position is achieved.
- For selective release using the threepoint polymer buckle:

- Determine whether to release the left side, right side, or both.
- Press the release mechanism to free the weapon from the sling.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the sling in accordance with local waste management regulations.
- If the sling is damaged beyond repair, consider recycling materials where possible.
- Do not dispose of the sling in regular household waste if it contains materials that can be hazardous.
