Easily adjustable to allow variations in stoning angle for exact, desired trigger pull weight. Same tool Ron Power uses in his own shop. Complete with one adapter and very detailed instructions written by Ron. You will also need a #10 Machinist's Clamp and 6"x½"x½" stones (listed elsewhere). ab

Introduction
