Set stoning angle by counting "clicks" specified to raise or lower elevator and stoning guide. Lock guide, place stone on both roller and hammer or trigger/sear, and stone as normal. Easily adjustable to allow variations in stoning angle for exact, desired trigger pull weight. Same tool Ron Power uses in his own shop. Complete with one adapter and very detailed instructions written by Ron. You will also need a #10 Machinist's Clamp and 6"x½"x½" stones (listed elsewhere). ab

Safety Instruction Guide for the SERIES I STONING FIXTURE POWER CUSTOM CSA ADAPTER

Introduction

- Place the stone on both the roller and hammer or trigger/sear.
- Begin stoning as per normal procedures, ensuring to maintain control and focus.

6. PostUse Care

- After use, clean the fixture and store it in a safe location.
- Regularly check for any wear or damage to the fixture or accessories.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the fixture and any wornout accessories in accordance with local regulations.
