The price is a little higher but no lubrication is needed and your cases will glide through the sizing die. Pro Series Pistol Die Sets are designed for use in progressive reloading machines. The expander die is eliminated from the set and a separate crimp die is substituted. The set includes a carbide sizing die, bullet seater (no crimp type), and a separate crimp die. Please note: These dies are specifically designed for progressive machines that expand the case mouth at the powder metering station so no expander die is included with this die set.

Introduction

- Install the bullet seater die in the press, ensuring it is properly adjusted for the desired bullet length.
- Install the separate crimp die as the last step in the process.

3. Reloading Process:

- Start by resizing the cases using the carbide sizing die. Ensure cases are clean and free of debris.
- After resizing, proceed to the powder metering station to dispense the appropriate amount of powder into each case.
- Place a bullet on top of the powderfilled case and use the bullet seater die to seat the bullet to the desired depth.
- Finally, use the crimp die to apply a crimp to the case mouth, ensuring the bullet is securely held in

place.

4. PostReloading:

- Inspect each round for proper seating and crimping.
- Store reloaded ammunition in a safe and organized manner, clearly labeled with the caliber and load information.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any unused or damaged components in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not throw away used primers or powder in regular trash. Follow local hazardous waste disposal guidelines.
- Recycle packaging materials where possible.
