- After seating, lower the ram and inspect the bullet for correct seating depth.
- Repeat the process for additional rounds as needed.

3. Postusage:

- After use, clean the die with a soft cloth to remove any residue.
- Store the die in its original packaging or a secure container to prevent damage.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any packaging materials in accordance with local regulations.
- If the die is damaged beyond repair, contact your local waste management facility for proper disposal instructions.
