Safety Instructions for Redding Competition Seater Die 300 PRC

Introduction

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation:

- Clean the threads of the die and reloading press to ensure a proper fit.
- Screw the die into the reloading press until it is snug but not overly tight.
- Set the micrometer to your desired starting seating depth.

2. Usage:

- Prepare your brass cases as per standard reloading practices.
- Insert a bullet into the case mouth.
- Place the case in the reloading press and lower the ram to seat the bullet.
- Adjust the micrometer as needed for precise seating depth. The micrometer is calibrated in .001" increments and is infinitely adjustable.
- After achieving the desired seating depth, use the zero set feature to mark this depth for future reloads.
- Inspect each round after seating to ensure proper bullet placement and depth.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any defective or damaged dies in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not throw the die in regular household waste; consult your local waste management authority for proper disposal methods.
