Safety Instruction Guide for TRIGGER SPRING TRIGGER SPRING FOR RUGER MINI14 & RUGER MINI30

Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the TRIGGER SPRING designed for the Ruger Mini14 and Mini30 rifles. This guide provides essential safety instructions and information to ensure the safe use and installation of this product. Please read this document carefully before using the product.
