TOOLMAKERS PARALLEL CLAMPS SAFETY INSTRUCTION GUIDE

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Toolmakers Parallel Clamps from Brownells. These clamps are designed for precision holding of unusual shapes, making them essential tools for toolmakers and gunsmiths. This guide provides important safety instructions to ensure the safe and effective use of the clamps.

General Safety Guidelines

 - #005 2" (5.1cm) long jaws, 1.285" (3.3cm) jaw spread.
 - #010 3" (7.6cm) long jaws, 2.185" (5.5cm) jaw spread.
 - #015 4" (10.2cm) long jaws, 2.95" (7.5cm) jaw spread.
- Avoid using the clamps in wet or slippery conditions to prevent accidents.
- Store the clamps in a dry place to prevent rust and deterioration.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation

- Ensure you have a clean work area free from clutter.
- Gather any additional tools you may need for your specific application.

2. Setting Up the Clamps

- Open the jaws of the clamp by turning the handle counterclockwise.
- Position the material you wish to hold between the jaws.
