Safety Instruction Guide for TRIGGER GROUP COMPETITION PAK for GLOCK®

Introduction

- Perform a function check to ensure that the trigger and safety mechanisms are operating correctly.

3. PostInstallation:

- Test the firearm in a safe and controlled environment to ensure that the trigger pull meets your expectations.
- Regularly check the performance of the new springs and ensure that they are functioning as

intended.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any old springs and components in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of any firearm components in regular household waste. Instead, check with local waste management authorities for proper disposal methods.
