# Safety Instruction Guide for 17113 RUGER® SP101® KIT

## Introduction

- Select the desired reduced power hammer spring from the kit (9 lb., 10 lb., or 12 lb.).

- Remove the existing trigger return spring with the screwdriver.
- Install the 8 lb. reduced power trigger return spring from the kit, ensuring it is securely in place.

## 5. Testing

- Perform a function check in a safe environment to ensure that the firearm operates correctly with the new springs.
