

All springs are variable power. 18 lb. spring is factory standard; includes extra power firing pin spring.

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the COLT COMMANDER VARIABLE POWER RECOIL SPRING 12 LB. manufactured by WOLFF. This product is designed to enhance the performance of your Colt Commander firearm. To ensure safe operation and handling, please read and follow the instructions and safety guidelines outlined in this document.

General Safety Guidelines
