Designed with 4 sets of compression straps and 2 rows of Hypalon-reinforced cinched MOLLE, this bag is designed to carry all your essential clothing and gear. It even features 4 carry options for the DeathGrip tripod! The Helix 3500 features bottom-of-bag access for gear that has made its way down as you trek in. Included with the Helix 3500 is a removable 150D micro-ripstop rain cover, and a detachable gun/bow/DeathGrip carry boot.
