The Bench-Rest (BR)-Neck-Die guides the cartridge case over the full length before the cartridge case will be formed with an interchangeable precision ground bushing.

The guide sleeve has the internal contour of the cartridge chamber to cover the cartridge case.

The guide sleeve and the body of this reloading-die are perfectly matched to ensure exact axial alignment of the cartridge during the sizing process.

Of course, the BR-Neck-sizer has an optional expander and the exchangeable primer ejector pin.

This die is the perfect choice for those, who want to leave nothing to chance when reloading.

All relevant components have an article number for easy reordering if necessary.

You will find further instructions and assistance in selecting accessories and spare parts in the manual.
