Introduction

- Slowly pull the handle of the reloading press to seat the bullet. Ensure that the bullet is guided properly by the seater head.
- If desired, adjust the crimping feature to secure the bullet in place.

3. Crimping the Cartridge

- After seating the bullet, if crimping is desired, adjust the crimping depth using the seater head settings.
- Pull the handle of the reloading press again to apply the crimp to the cartridge case mouth.

- Inspect the cartridge to ensure proper seating and crimping.

4. Cleaning and Maintenance

- After use, clean the seater head and surrounding area to remove any debris.
- Regularly lubricate moving parts as recommended in the product manual.
- Store the product in a cool, dry place to prevent rust and damage.
