- Outer Diameter tapered to .800 the biggest lever-action OEM barrel (can be tapered down for all other smaller barrel OD's)
- Bore size is .328 for a .30-30 Win cartridge (can be bored out for larger cartridges)
- Bore size where threads will be cut is .465 to accommodate 1/2x28 tpi (can be bored out for different tpi)
