With an exit pupil range of roughly 14.0–4.2 mm, this scope maintains excellent brightness even in challenging light. A field of view of about 11.1–3.4 m at 100 m ensures generous situational awareness at low magnification and finer target definition at higher zoom levels.

Constructed on a durable 30 mm main tube, it delivers a low-mount profile and rugged build quality, with precise adjustments featuring a click value of 1 cm at 100 m for both elevation and windage.
