The field of view spans approximately 13.0–1.4 m at 100 m, while the exit pupil ranges around 8.7–2.1 mm. Generous eye relief of around 90 mm ensures comfortable alignment and a stable sight picture.

Built on a rugged 34 mm main tube, the scope is constructed for demanding environments. The turret system accommodates ultra-fine click values (e.g., ~0.1 mrad) and massive internal adjustment ranges for elevation and windage—making it suitable for long-range engagement scenarios. Parallax adjustment commonly spans from around 10 m to infinity, giving flexibility across varied target distances.
