All components are captive in the lightweight, aluminum alloy housing. Hammer is wire-EDM machined from S7 tool steel that combines hardness to resist wear with superior impact resistance to withstand heavy use without chipping or breaking. Other components are EDM cut from A2 tool steel, then heat treated to Rc 56-60 for long service life. The Brownells exclusive model offers you all the same features of the curved trigger shoe model, but with a unique tan anodized body. Installs using your rifle's original hammer/trigger pins, our proprietary design eliminates pin walkout. Available in curved or flat trigger bows. The secret to long-range accuracy? It all starts with an amazing trigger and this trigger, is truly amazing. The new Impact trigger is Timney's latest overnight success - 73 years in the making. AR15 Triggers Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction
