This is a complete, drop-in trigger assembly from Timney that uses the rifle's existing hammer and trigger pins as well as the standard safety. No gunsmithing is required, no adjustments are necessary, and no additional parts are needed for installation.

Available with different trigger shoe options to match your preferred feel and shooting style, the Timney AR PCC Trigger is ready for the range right out of the box and designed to help you shoot faster and more accurately.
