Specifically engineered for shooters who prefer a two-stage trigger in AR-style pistol caliber carbines, it delivers improved control, consistency, and accuracy. Installation is quick and easy with no gunsmithing required, and the trigger is ready for the range straight out of the box with no adjustments necessary. It features a solid, straight trigger shoe.

Safety Instruction Guide for AR PCC Triggers

Introduction
