Unlike standard gas-operated AR triggers, which often fail or wear quickly under the harsher hammer impact of these systems, this trigger is engineered to function reliably and safely in such platforms. Factory-set at 3.5 lbs (approx. 1,590 g), it delivers a crisp, single-stage pull with no creep.

Safety Instruction Guide for Timney Impact AR PCC Trigger

Introduction
